The CN Tower is a soaring 553.3 meter high concrete communications and observation tower in downtown Toronto. It was built on the former Railway Lands and was completed on June 26, 1976. It was built by the Canadian National Railway Company and was initially privately owned but is now managed by a public corporation. Climb up to the clouds, test your nerves, and ascend to the highest observation platform in the Western Hemisphere!



Ground transportation from the Toronto Pearson International Airport | YYZ

RENTAL CARS

Avis/Budget, Dollar/Thrifty, Enterprise, Hertz ad National/Alamo are all on site for quick, efficient car rentals at Pearson Airport.

TRAIN TO CITY (UP EXPRESS)

Union Pearson Express runs from Pearson Airport to Union Station in downtown Toronto in just 25 minutes.

TAXIS & LIMOS

Travel from Toronto Pearson International Airport to the Metro Toronto Convention Centre in approximately 30 min.

PRE-ARRANGED SERVICES

Pre-arrange your Pearson Airport taxi, limo or bus before your arrival.

RIDE SHARING

Ride sharing services are available at Pearson Airport. Request a pick-up from either terminal.

PUBLIC TRANSIT BUSES

Pearson Airport buses travel to Toronto and surrounding areas. Check next departure times or use the trip planner to map your route.

PICKING UP & DROPPING OFF

When your friends and family arrive at Pearson Airport, you can be right there to great them.

Travel from Pearson International Airport to the Metro Toronto Convention Center is approximately 30 min or 27 km.
